- *Wages, salaries, tips and commissions;*
- *Self-employment income from a business;*
- *Interest, dividends, net rental income or income from estates and trusts;*
- *Social Security or railroad retirement income;*
- *Supplemental Security Income, Aid to Families with Dependant Children or other public welfare programs;*
- *Retirement, survivor or disability pensions;*
- *Any other source of income received regularly including Veterans' (VA) payments, unemployment compensation and alimony*
